POPULATION—Bellair 13,327.

NEFFS 3,059.

PREVAILING WINDS—Southwest.

PAVING—About 22 miles of paved streets; other streets cinder or gravel except as noted.

GRADES—Mostly level.

WATER FACILITIES

Municipal ownership. Source from Ohio River. Gravity pressure system. Water pumped from river to storage tanks by 1 Pumping Station. One 1000 gpm pump and 1 Diesel driven pump, capacity 4,000,000 and 5,000,000 gallons per 24 hours respectively. 1 Dean and 1 Fairbanks-Morse pump, each 1000 gpm, capacity 4,000,000 gallons per 24 hours. Pump directs water into mains and one 1,750,000 gallon reservoir on hill 213' above business section.

11 miles of 12" mains, 250 double and triple hydrants. Average daily consumption 3,500,000 gallons. Pressure 60 to 70 lbs.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

1 chief, 2 assistant chief and 6 drivers, fully paid. 19 volunteers. 3 companies in 3 station houses.

CENTRAL STATION—1 Seagrave triple combination truck with 600 gpm pump, one 1000 gpm pump, one 40 gallon booster tank, 2,500' 21" hose, 200' 1½" hose and 250' 1½" hose.

NORTH END STATION—1 American-LaFrance triple combination truck with 600 gpm pump, one 1000 gpm pump, one 100 gallon booster tank, 1,000' 21" hose, 200' 1½" hose and 250' 1½" hose.

SOUTH END STATION—1 Seagrave triple combination truck with 600 gpm pump, one 1000 gpm pump, one 40 gallon chemical tank, 1,000' 21" hose and 250' 1½" hose.

Central Fire Station system, 40 boxes. Alarm system located in Central Fire Station, a brick wooden joint building.
